**RESOLUTION APPROVING A PROJECT TO EXTEND
THE BENEFITS AND OPPORTUNITIES OF GIRL SCOUT PROGRAMMING
TO AT-RISK GIRLS IN DESIGNATED PRIORITY FUNDING AREAS
IN WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND**

WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay (the "Girl Scouts"), a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake a project known as "Girl Scout Leadership Experience" to extend the benefits and opportunities of Girl Scout programming to at-risk girls in designated priority funding areas in Worcester County, Maryland (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Girl Scouts serves girls in kindergarten through twelfth grade and the Council is dedicated to reaching out to the girls whose families struggle with the burdens of poverty, crime, drugs, lack of employment, lack of education, and hopelessness through the "Girl Scout Leadership Experience" which helps these girls to **Discover** potential in themselves, **Connect** with other girls, and **Take Action** to make the world a better place; and

WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts have applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) of the State of Maryland for approval of the Project and an allocation of tax credits for business and individual entities that contribute to the Project, under the DHCD's Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland approve the Project.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland hereby expresses approval of the Project, as described above.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.


