

RESOLUTION NO. 20 - 35

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AMENDMENTS FOR OFFICE BUILDING RECYCLING
TO THE COMPREHENSIVE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN
FOR WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 370, Section 9-1714 to the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, was passed by the State legislature to require the collection of recyclable materials from office buildings that have 150,000 square feet or greater of officer space; requiring each owner of an office building to provide recycling receptacles for the collection of recyclable materials and for the removal of certain materials for further recycling by October 1, 2021; authorizing certain enforcement units to conduct certain inspections; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners held a public hearing on November 4, 2020 to receive public comment on the proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan after which they have determined to adopt the amended language as proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland that the Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan for Worcester County, Maryland, 2017-2026 is hereby amended as described above to comply all applicable laws.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.


