Item	Questions and Answers
1	Bed size 6.5' Ford only uses 5.5' bed length, Engine requested is an eight-cylinder Ford uses 3.5 turbo V6, would the Ford be acceptable? FORD WEBSITE STATES 5.0V8 IS AVAILABLE FOR F150, SUPERCAB 4X4 6.5FT BED IS A OPTION ON FORDS WEBSITE. THE ABOVE IF BID WOULD NOT BE ACCEPTABLE.
2	Ford Explorer PPV uses 3.3L v6 Turbo, no V8 option. Ford doesn't offer split tail gate. Would this be acceptable? NO
3	Ford doesn't Offer Explorer PPV with 4x2, only AWD, would this be acceptable? NO
4	Ford only offers a 3.5 Turbo V6 option, with a 5.5' Bed, would this be acceptable? YES
5	Expedition SSV is only available with 3.5L V6 Turbo, No V8 Option, would this be acceptable? YES
6	Ford Ranger 4 Cylinder is a 2.3L Turbo 4 Cylinder, would this be acceptable? YES, 2.3L is fine
